Pupil Premium Historical Information

<u>2011/12</u>

In 2011/12 Ashford Park was allocated £17,200 (40 pupils @ £430 per pupil) and the money was used as follows:

- Employment of a Home School Link Worker supporting families and helping pupils to feel happy and secure in school.
- Small group provision to support progress in Maths and Literacy.
- Small group provision to develop progress with Social and Emotional skills including Nurture Groups.
- Analysis and support for progression in language, speaking and listening skills.
- Lunchtime clubs to extend a variety of skills. These have included: Science, ICT, Makaton, Art & Craft, Sewing and Street Art.

IMPACT OF INITIATIVES

The progress of the very large majority of our identified children was in line with or above national expectations.

The **SERVICE PREMIUM** for children whose parents are currently serving in the armed forces was £200. There were no service families at Ashford Park during 2011 - 2012.

<u>2012/13</u>

In 2012/13 the funding has been increased to £600 per pupil and extended to include pupils who have been eligible to receive FSM at any point in the last 6 years.

At Ashford Park we have 56 eligible pupils and our funding will therefore be £33,600 in 2012/13.

We will be extending our initiatives of 2011/12 to include the additional pupils and also the amount of intervention time that the pupils have.

The **SERVICE PREMIUM** has risen to £250 and is designed to address the emotional and social well-being of these pupils whose parents are currently serving in the armed forces.
