children celebrate their learning.

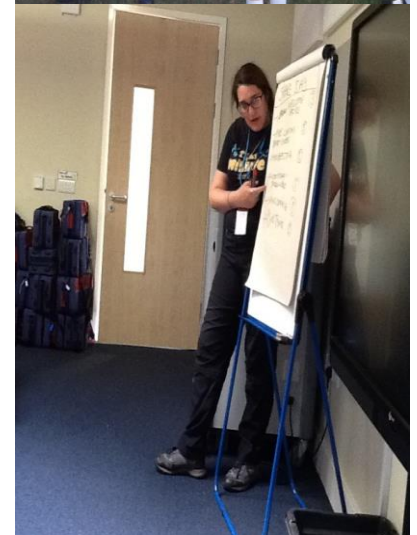


John Muir Award – Conserve Day
