Bike Safety

We have spoken to the children in Years 5 & 6 about safety on bikes, and the consequences of irresponsible behaviour on or near roads. This included the following;

- All children must walk their bikes out of school - no feet on pedals.
- When walking from the bike shed (by kitchen) to the gate, they must walk on the path.
- When leaving the school they must walk their bike across the road and only cycle when they are clear of pedestrians.
- **No child should be on a bike without a helmet.**

- They must leave distance between themselves and the bike in front so that they do not have to suddenly stop / swerve into road.
