



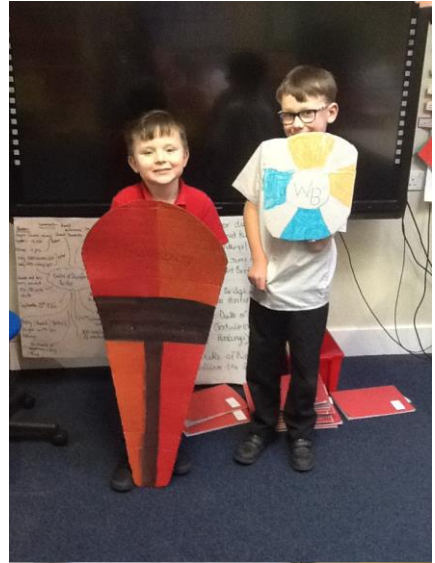
Year 3 Home Learning
