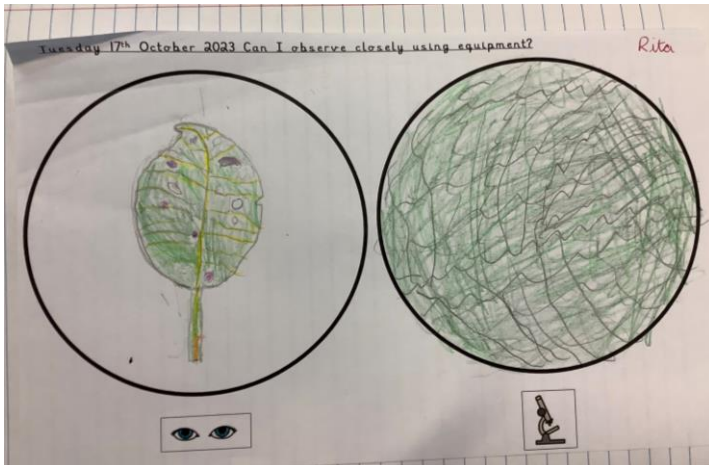


"When we came back to school on Tuesday 31st October, I was surprised to see a shoot from one of our bulbs."



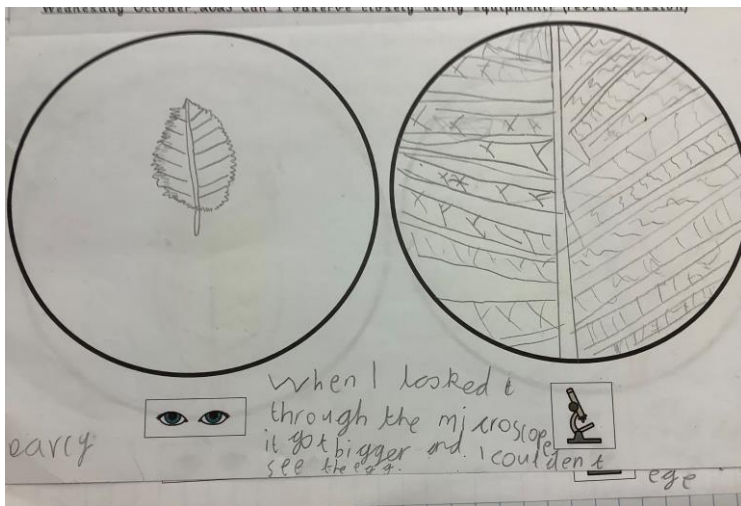
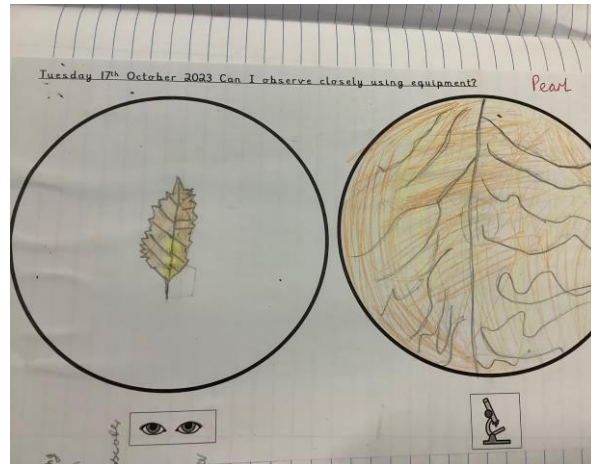
"I couldn't believe it has opened already!"

They have to be creative and designing experiments is a creative process involving asking lots of questions.




