Please do this by Monday 17th April 2023. We appreciate that there is a cost involved with this music experience, but hope that as the choir club is offered on a free basis, this contributes towards the cost.

Our programme of extending the curriculum has been highlighted by OFSTED as one of the things that the school does particularly well. However, whilst we feel that the programme of visits is very important to the children's learning, we also appreciate that it requires a sizeable financial commitment from parents.
