Time of departure:	Children should arrive at school at 8:30am as normal, we will leave at approx. 9.00am
Estimated time of return:	3.00 pm
Mode of travel:	Coach or Minibus - all children will have their own seatbelts
Dress:	School Uniform
Lunch arrangements:	You need to send your child in with a packed lunch and a drink
	(no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please). The children will need to
	carry their lunches so we suggest they bring them in a plastic bag so
	they can be disposed of easily when finished
Contribution:	£19 - To cover the cost of entry and transport

If you agree to your son/daughter participating in the visit, please give consent and pay on Scopay or return the form and your voluntary contribution to the school office clearly marked: Reception – Kidzania with your child's name and his/her class, **by 6th June 2023.**

As the school's resources are limited, the visit will not take place if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the visit.

We need some parent volunteers to attend the trip. If you are able to help please click the button on the Scopay consent by Wednesday 24th May. If we have more volunteers than we need we will pull names out of a hat. We will confirm volunteers during week commencing 5th June.

Our programme of extending the curriculum has been highlighted by OFSTED as one of the things that the school does particularly well. However, whilst we feel that the programme of visits is very important to the children's learning, we also appreciate that it requires a sizeable financial commitment from parents. We would therefore encourage parents who experience difficulty in making necessary contributions to arrange to see Sarah Tarrant, Headteacher, in confidence, at the earliest opportunity, as the school is able to assist in cases of hardship.
