New Site Manager

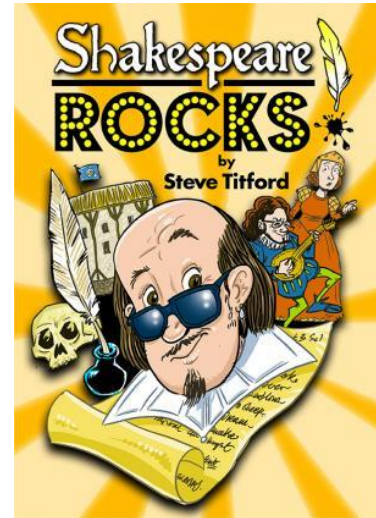


We would like to introduce Mr Hiren Pandya, our new Site Manager.
