Our Changing World

- Choose a location/landscape of your choice (Specific beach, coastal area, national trust site, national heritage site), identify the human and physical geographical features of this location.
- Research what a biome is and create an information document about what you find.
- Find out about different types of weathering and compare the similarities and differences between them.

- Draw or print off an animal and/or plant and label the characteristics that have allowed them to adapt to their environment.
- Design, invent and draw a diagram of a plant or an animal that can live in an environment of your choice. Write a report of how y
- Create a poster/presentation to explain what you have inherited from your parents/family? Example: eye colour, dimples, etc., but how are you different from your parents/family members?
- Explore different parts of the world and research the variety of animals that live in these specific areas.
