<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The overview for each half term will be uploaded to the school website. This details what the children will be working on each week but is <i>subject to change</i>. • We plan homework tasks very carefully to support and consolidate school learning. Please support and encourage your child to complete the tasks set and communicate with their teacher if they have any problems doing so. • Where possible, please work on your child's individual targets. These are sent home each term, at half term (October, February, May). • All home learning for online platforms will be set from week commencing 18th September 2023. • Maths Shed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Maths Shed tasks will be assigned for home learning each Thursday which must be completed by the following Thursday. This will be linked to the maths learning in lessons that week. ○ Children in Years 3-6 can practice their times tables using the Times Table Rock Stars site. • English <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Reading – A reading book is sent home twice a week with your child's reading record on a Tuesday and Friday. ○ When your child is secure with their phonic knowledge, they will be allocated books to read on e-Collins. Please ensure that your child reads daily. ○ Spelling – Children who Spelling Shed are ready to attempt spellings, will have spellings set on a Friday using Spelling Shed and needs to be completed by the following Friday. • Username and passwords for online home learning will be sent via Marvellous Me. 	<p>One PE session will be with the children's mainstream class and the other will be in the Acorn Centre as part of our gross motor and occupational therapy provision. Please refer to your child's Year group newsletter for details about their PE days. Children are not required to wear their PE kit for Acorn sessions.</p> <p>The expectation is that your child comes into school in their PE kit on their mainstream PE days. Please ensure each item of your child's PE kit is clearly labelled with their name and no jewellery is worn on PE days.</p> <tr> <th colspan="2" style="background-color: #4a86e8; color: white; text-align: center;">Marvellous Me</th> </tr> <tr> <td colspan="2"> <p>Marvellous Me will be used to send out key information as well as to celebrate your child's successes. It is essential that you are signed up to the app and that you check it regularly.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"></div> <p>Your child's home-school communication book will be used to communicate key information, such as sleep issues and medication. 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At APPS, we follow The Literary Curriculum with Literacy Tree, which places quality literature at the core of English teaching. Below are the texts that we will study over the course of the term. If you are able to discuss the books with your child as we study them, it would really support their learning. All books are available from bookshops and local libraries. Please refer to the whole school text overview on the school's website for the texts studied in the spring and summer terms.
