CHILDREN WITH ALLERGIES AT ASHFORD PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL

Please be advised and reminded that we have a number of pupils in the school who have allergies, some of which are severe and could be life-threatening.

If you are planning to provide edible treats on your child's birthday or for any other celebration such as Christmas and Easter, we ask that you exercise care and consideration towards the welfare of **ALL pupils**.

Allergies that we currently have at the school include: **nut, dairy including milk, soy, egg, lentil, fish, sesame, birch, kiwi and gluten.**

When bringing treats into school:

- Please ensure that any treats are **handed into the office, clearly labelled with your child's name and class.**
- **Do not wrap treats** as this prevents the teacher from being able to identify the contents, eg. do not place in envelopes or gift paper. Any wrapped / enveloped treat **will be opened by an adult to ensure the safety of every child.**
- Treats will be distributed at the end of the school day.
- Treats are for consumption after school whilst in your care.

If in doubt, please ask your child's teacher.
