Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for the support you have given your children so far with their weekly home learning. This is an invaluable way for the children to reinforce and practice the learning that takes place in school.

As we move swiftly into the Spring Term, in order to keep preparing the children for their SATs and the transition to secondary school, they will now begin daily home learning taken from the CGP SATs Buster Bundle. This will replace their current weekly, online, home learning tasks.

At the beginning of every week, children will be asked to write the homework for the full week. There will be the equivalent of 2-6 pages from up to two CGP books per day. Although we will write the homework up as a daily schedule, we will not be marking the work until Friday afternoon. This will give you the opportunity to manage your after school time and enable your child to do extra homework on any given day if, for example, your child has a club on a particular night.

In addition, on Mondays, the children will be given up to 2 spelling patterns to learn from the CGP spelling book and expected to complete the learning on those pages throughout the week. The children will be tested on 15 spellings, based on these patterns on Friday, when we will also discuss the learning from those pages.

Although we have given these books to your children for free to support their learning, it is essential that they are kept safe and brought back to school each day as we will be using these books to support learning in the classroom too. If any book is lost, you will be charged £3.95 (plus postage and packaging) to replace the book, to ensure your child is not missing out on learning opportunities.

We continue to expect the children to read independently for at least ten minutes each evening and then discuss what they have read with an adult. The reading records should continue to be signed and returned to school each day.
