Life 360

We are aware that some parents like to check that their child has arrived at school. This is particularly relevant to children when they reach Year 6, and they are coming to school independently and have phones. Some children have been asked by their parents to text when they get to school, but they occasionally forget.

There is a tracking app called Life360 where parents can track their children. It tracks the child (for free) and you can have two locations saved, without upgrading, so that it can notify you when the child arrives and leaves that location e.g. home and school.
