


*Situated on the beautiful Hampshire coast, Stubbington Study Centre is a Children's Services facility available to schools and other pre-booked groups for residentials and more.*

# Our trip

- The dates of the trip TBC. They will be Feb/March 2025
- Each day will involve a wide variety of activities and teambuilding exercises, many of these will be supporting our curriculum:
  - Exploring an Anglo Saxon Longhouse
  - Beach explorations
  - Teambuilding orienteering activities to support our PE curriculum
- We will be staying at Stubbington for 2 nights.
- We strongly recommend that all children attend the trip as it is a great opportunity for their learning to come to life!

# What do you need to do next?

- A letter was sent out on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> November outlining the approximate cost of the trip (£190) which includes 3 cooked meals a day, all activities, accommodation and coach journey.
