We are delighted to inform you that Mrs Tarrant has continued with her passion for lifelong learning, and recently graduated

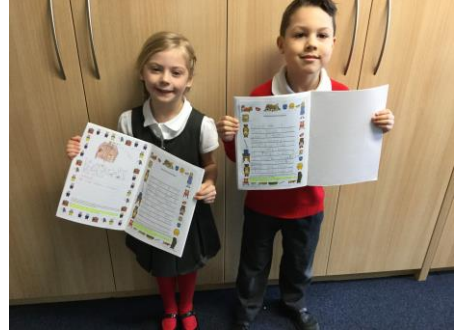
