The deadline for projects to be uploaded to Google Classroom or brought into school is **Monday 15th December 2025**.

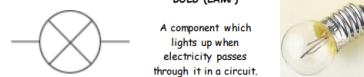
World War 2

1. Research a WW2 recipe and make it at home with an adult. Photograph the meal or dish and write out the recipe. Write a review of the meal - consider the method, its appearance and taste. What possible improvements could be made?
2. Research and write a short biography about a significant person from WW2 e.g. Winston Churchill.
3. Research & create a fact file on a key event in WW2 e.g. Battle of Britain, the Blitz, VE day or D-Day.
4. Draw and label a great airplane from WW2 e.g. British Supermarine Spitfire.
5. Write instructions or an advice leaflet for citizens to follow during an air raid.

Electricity

1. Investigate electrical devices. Look around your home for different devices that use electricity i.e. torch, TV, remote controls etc. and work out if they run on mains electricity or batteries. Are there some that could be both? Use a Venn diagram to sort them.
2. Explore the components of an electrical circuit. Create an activity or game that will challenge Year 6 children to identify and match the symbol,

definition and image of the component. E.g.



3. Research a famous scientist who created an important electrical invention and present your findings in a format of your choice.
