Home Learning

- Mathematics
 - Mathletics tasks will be assigned for home learning each Thursday which must be completed by the following Thursday. This will be linked to the maths learning in lessons that week.
 - On a daily basis for at least 10 minutes, your child should practice their times tables using the Maths Shed site.
- English **Spelling Shed**
 - Reading - Please ensure that your child reads daily and discuss the text they have read. It is useful to explore new vocabulary using a dictionary. More details on reading books and reading records will follow.
 - Spelling – A Spelling Shed activity will be set each Monday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.
- **Usernames and passwords for online home learning will be glued into their Reading Record.**

PE Days & PE Kits

Our PE days are on Monday and Friday for all of Year 5. **The expectation is that your child comes into school in their PE kit on those days.** Please ensure each item of your child’s PE kit is labelled clearly with their name and that no jewellery is worn on PE days.



Marvellous Me will be used to send out key information as well as to celebrate your child’s successes. It is essential that you are signed up to the app and that you check it regularly.
