Comparing two places - London and Lagos

2. From what you find out at home and in school, write a report which shares all of your exciting learning about Lagos. Be sure to include the similarities and differences that you have identified between LAgos and the UK.

Plants

1. Create your own miniature garden. You could make it in a box or a plant pot.
2. Write a plant or flower poem. This could be an acrostic poem that spells out a flower or plant.
3. Design a seed packet with instructions on how to keep the plant healthy once it is planted. You could include illustrations. You could even make a real packet with homemade paper seeds inside!
