Animals including humans

- 1) Create model of the human skeleton system. Make the main bones of the human body and label them, describing their function.
- 2) What does a healthy lunchbox look like? Draw and label a healthy packed lunch and explain the nutrients provided by each item.
- 3) Research the diet of an animal. Compare it to what you eat. What is different about it? Why does the animal eat what it eats?

Natural disasters

Disaster Fact File

Choose one natural disaster (volcano, earthquake, flood, tsunami, hurricane).

Include:

- What it is
 - Where it happens
 - One famous example
 - 3 interesting facts
- Add pictures or drawings.

Disaster in a Shoebox

Make a 3D model showing a natural disaster using recycled materials (lego, cardboard, clay, paper).

Draw & Label

Draw a volcano / tsunami / hurricane and label the important parts.

Comic Strip

Create a short comic showing what happens *before, during and after* a natural disaster.

Volcano Eruption (Adult help)

Use baking soda, vinegar, and food colouring to create an eruption.

Write or draw what happened.
