Find excitement and interest in Maths and number within your child's daily life.

Model and encourage your child to:

- Count a group of objects.
- Recognise digits to 10 and then 20.
- Say which group has more or fewer objects.
- Subitise amounts to 5
(recognise amounts without counting)

Physical Development

- Squeeze playdough in your hands to strengthen your fingers.
- Practice forming the letters we have learnt.
- Can you throw and catch a ball?

PSHE

In PSHE we are learning about 'Celebrating Differences'.

- Can you say how you are different to and the same from a friend?
- What makes you proud?
- What are you good at doing?
- What can you do to make a friend?
- How can you tell when someone is feeling sad, angry or upset?
- If someone is making you feel sad or upset what can you do about it?
