Seasonal Changes - Spring & Summer

1. Season favourites- choose your favourite thing about each season to draw and label. It could be the weather, an event such as Wimbledon or an occasion such as a birthday or a festival.
2. Look at an information book or age-appropriate videos and websites online with an adult to learn more about the weather and seasons. Write one or more fascinating facts to show something that you have learned after reading and listening. Draw a picture to match your fascinating facts.
3. Think about the equipment, footwear and clothing that people need during the different seasons. Record your results in lists or as a table.

Victorians

1. Look at an information book or age-appropriate videos and websites online with an adult to learn more about Queen Victoria. Create a fact file to show something that you have learnt after reading and listening. Draw a picture to match your interesting facts.
2. Imagine you are living in Victorian times. Write a paragraph describing three things you would like about living in that time and three things you don't think you would like. Remember to say why.
3. Write a timetable of a normal school day for you, then write a timetable of a Victorian school child's day and find 3 ways they are different.
