Living Things & Their Habitats

1. Create Your Own Classification Key - "What Is It?" Project

Choose 6-8 living things.

Identify key features such as flowers/no flowers, vertebrate/invertebrate, fur/no fur, can fly/cannot fly.

Create a yes/no branching classification key.

Present as a poster, flow chart, or booklet.

2. Habitats Under Threat - Environment Change Project

Choose one habitat (rainforest, woodland, ocean, river).

Explain natural changes (fires, floods) and human changes (pollution, deforestation, urbanisation).

Describe how these changes affect living things.

Create a before-and-after poster, model, or slideshow.

Sustainable Produce - Farm to Fork

1. Where in the World Does Our Food Come From?

- Choose 8-10 food items from the kitchen.
- Find out where each food comes from.
- Mark these countries on a world map.
- Add the climate zone and likely transport method.

2. From Farm to Fork - Food Journey Storyboard

- Choose a food (bread, chocolate, milk).
- Draw its journey: growing → harvesting → processing → packaging → transport → supermarket.
- Create a 6-8-box comic strip.

3. Local vs Global Food Challenge - Shopping Comparison

- Compare local and imported foods.
- Discuss why the UK can grow some foods and imports others.
- Create a poster encouraging buying local produce.
