### Ancient Maya

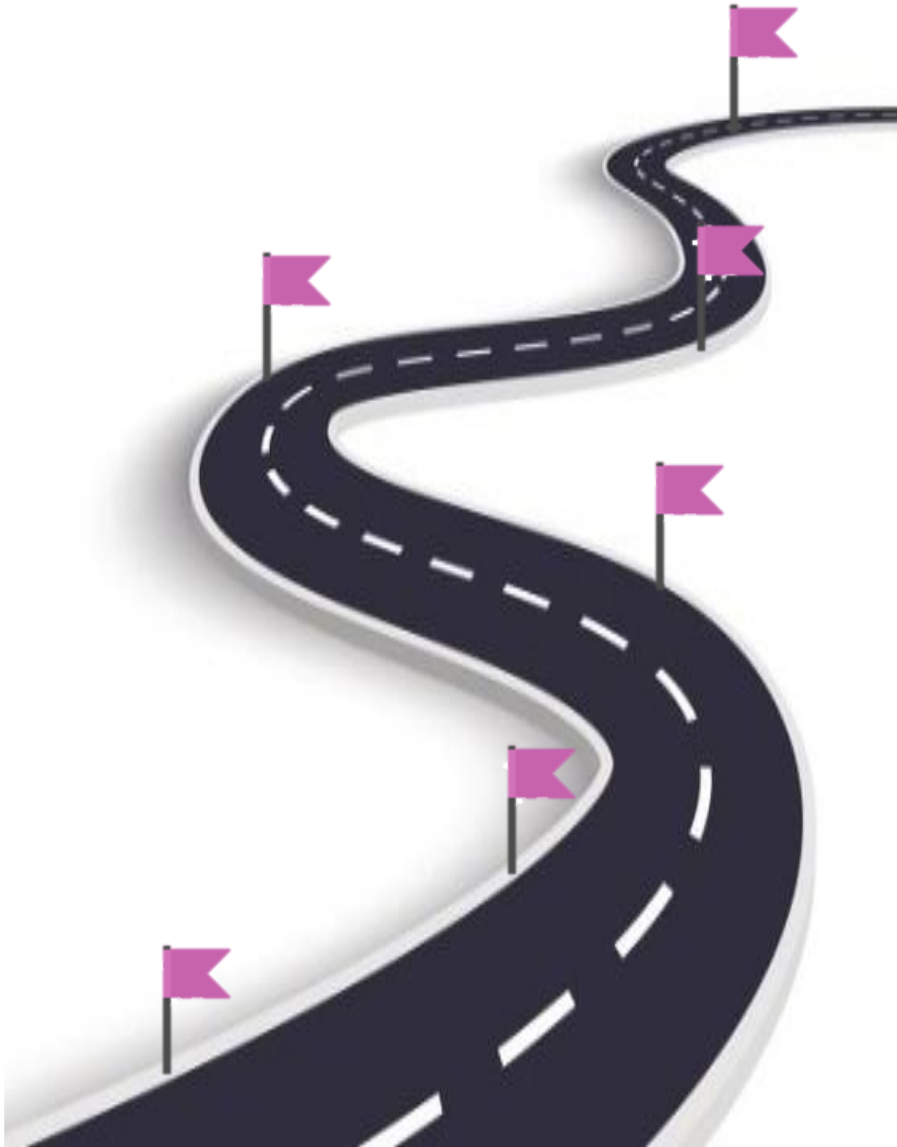
1. Create Maya bunting. Put information about various aspects of the Mayan civilisation on each flag.
2. Mexican artist, Pedro Linares, created fantastical sculptures of creatures by combining animals in unusual ways, such as a donkey with butterfly wings or a cockerel with horns. He called these sculptures alebrijes. They are traditionally made from papier mâché. Draw or sculpt a unique alebrije using Mexican wildlife as inspiration.
3. Research the Mayan gods and present your learning in a format of your choice.
