Home Learning

- We plan homework tasks very carefully to support and consolidate school learning. Therefore, it is vital that you support and encourage your child to complete the tasks sets and communicate with their teacher if they have any problems doing so.

Mathematics



- Mathletics tasks will be assigned for home learning each Thursday which must be completed by the following Thursday. This will be linked to the maths learning in lessons that week.
- Maths Shed activities will also be set for your child, with a focus on number bonds and times tables. 10 minutes daily.



English

- Reading – Please ensure that your child reads their phonically matched reading book regularly on Collins ebooks and that this is recorded in their reading record. These books will be set online on a Friday. To be read daily. A sharing book will be sent home twice a week with the reading record on a Tuesday and Friday. This is a book that you can enjoy reading together. Please ensure your child's reading record is in school every day.
- Spelling – A Spelling Shed activity will be set each Friday and needs to be completed by the following Friday. 10 minutes daily.
- **Username and passwords are stuck in your child's reading record.**

PE Days & PE Kits

The expectation is that your child comes into school in their PE kit on PE days.

Please ensure each item of your child's PE kit is clearly labelled with their name and no jewellery is worn on PE days. Year 2 PE days are **Thursday & Friday**.

Please make sure you are signed up to Arbor and include at least two contact phone numbers in case of illness or emergency.

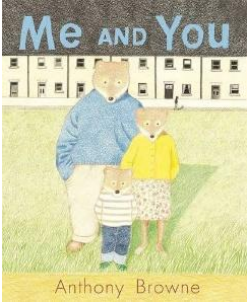
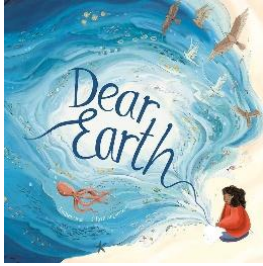
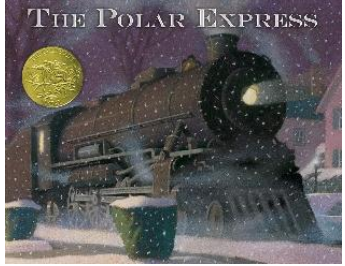
Please pre-order your child's lunches through Kanpla. This includes if your child is having packed lunch.
