### **Home learning**

This half term we are going to be learning about Animals including Humans in our science lessons and Mountains in our geography lessons. Please choose one activity from either subject to complete.

#### **Mountains**

1. Choose one of the world's highest mountains and create a PowerPoint/Google slides presentation all about it to show your class. Don't forget to include lots of interesting images and information BUT don't just copy information from a website.
2. Use a world map to locate the following mountains: Kilimanjaro, Mount Elbrus, Denali, Mount Aconcagua, Mount Everest, Vinson Massif and Mount Kosciuszko in Australia. Can you find out what the climate is like there and what lives there?
3. Create fact files about famous mountaineers such as Sir Edmund Hilary or Junko Tabei .

#### **Animals Including Humans**

1. Draw a diagram or create a model of the human digestive system showing all the main parts and organs. Could you research the function of each part and include this in your diagram/ model?
2. Find a mirror and have a look at your teeth. Notice the different sizes and shapes as you look from the front to the back of your mouth. Humans have four types of teeth; incisors, canines, premolars and molars. Use information books or the internet to research about the four types of teeth. Include the name of each tooth, what the tooth looks like, where it is found and its function. You could present your work as a report or diagram or model.
