This half term we are going to be learning about Rocks in our science lessons and the Stone age, Bronze age and Iron age in History lessons. Please choose **one** activity from either subject to complete.

The deadline for projects to be brought into school is Monday 12th October 2026

The Stone age Bronze age and Iron age

1. **Create a Prehistoric Timeline**
2. **Activity:** Make a large timeline on paper or cardboard showing:
 - a. Stone Age (Paleolithic → Neolithic)
 - b. Bronze Age
 - c. Iron Age

Add drawings or cut-out pictures of tools, homes, and clothes.

2. Make Your Own Prehistoric Tools

Stone Age: Use cardboard, foil, or sticks to make simple **hand axes or spears**.

Bronze/Iron Age: Draw or build models of metal tools.

Rocks

1. Go on a walk (garden, park, or around the home) and collect different rocks.

Observe and sort rocks based on **colour, texture, hardness, and appearance**.

Make a table or chart to classify rocks (e.g., smooth vs. rough, light vs. dark).

2. Research and make a mini booklet with pages for:
 - Igneous rocks (e.g., basalt, granite)
 - Sedimentary rocks (e.g., sandstone, limestone)
 - Metamorphic rocks (e.g., marble, slate)
