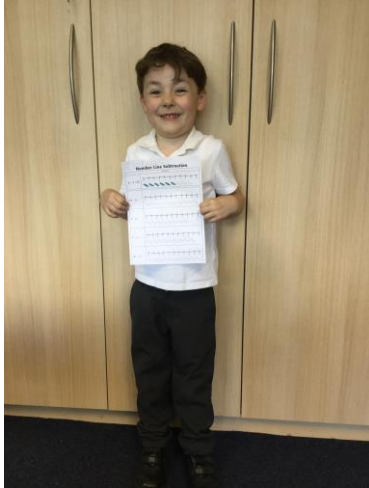
Year 2 SUPERSTARS
