**Football Trophies awarded to Caylib!**

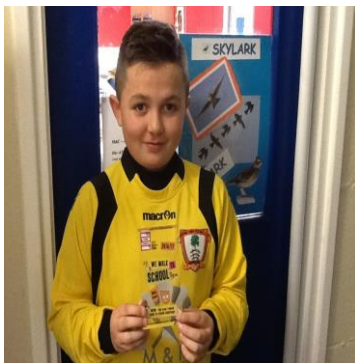


Well done to Caylib who was awarded the Man of the Match Star Trophy, chosen by the players.
