Truly fabulous PTA

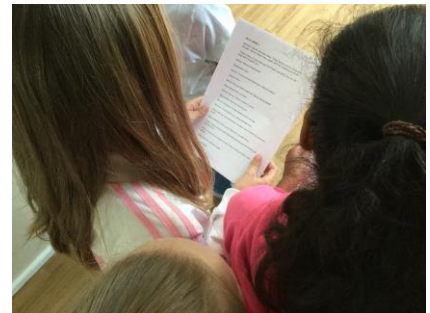
