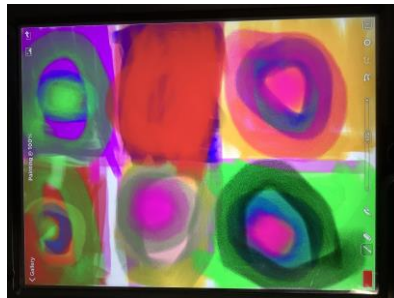
Bottle tops for Reception
