Cooking Club have been busy harvesting our soft fruit and using the harvest in Fruit Tarts, they were very nice!



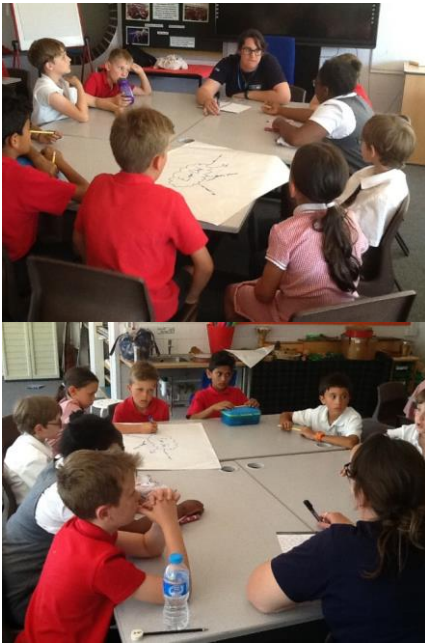
School Meals Years 3 – 6
