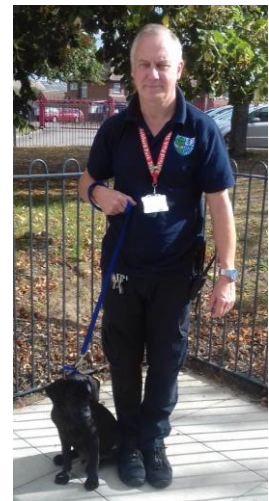
Dear Parent / Carer
