Just a reminder that if you would like your child to attend the Ultimate Adventure trip, the deposit is due by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December.

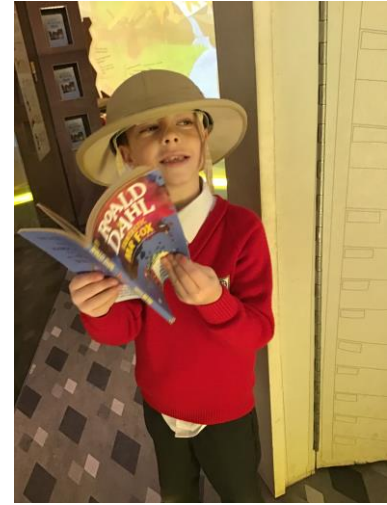
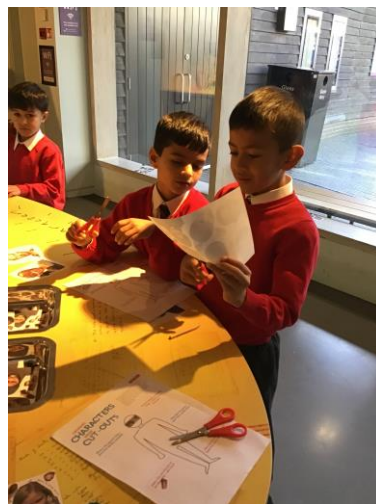
### Year 2 Roald Dahl Museum Trip

Please see quotes from the children below:

*"Don't be mean behind a screen" (cyber bullying)*

*"You should always tell an adult when you feel like you're being bullied"*

*"Never let anyone bully you or push you around, know your worth"*

*"If you ignore bullies, they will get bored – all they want is attention"*

*"Always help someone if you know they are being bullied"*

*"Be careful who you make friends with – don't always follow people because you think they're 'popular' or 'cool'"*

*"By not reporting bad behaviour / bullying, you are just as bad as the bully themselves"*

*"Cyber bullying is worse than bullying face to face as the person cannot be seen / recognised"*

*"Don't retaliate – if someone is bullying you or being mean, you do not need to do the same"*

*"Do not give out your personal information to people you don't trust"*

*"Don't be a bully, be a buddy"*

### **Primary, infant and junior applications**

You can apply for a place at a primary, infant or junior school from **4<sup>th</sup> November 2019**, if your child:

- was born between **1 September 2015** and **31 August 2016** they will be due to start school at either an infant or primary school in September 2020;
- is **leaving Year 2 of an infant school in July**

**2020** you will need to apply for a Year 3 place at a junior school or an all through primary school that has a year 3 entry to start in September 2020.

The closing date for on time applications for primary, infant and junior school is 15 January 2020.

If your child was born after 31 August 2016 you should start considering which schools you want to apply for at the beginning of the school year in which your child turns four. The annual closing date for applications is 15 January.
