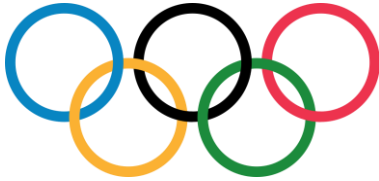




**Welcome back to the spring term and we hope that you have all had the opportunity to enjoy this festive time.**

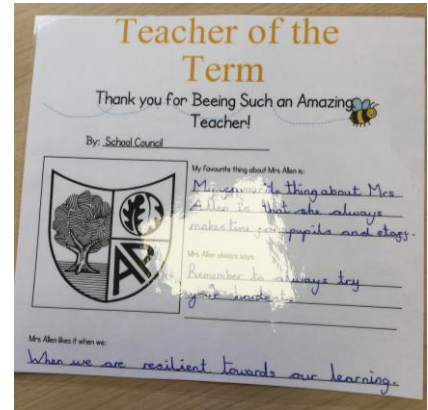
Well done to Amelia and Jessica who have both received certificates from the Sea Cadets for successfully advancing to the Junior Cadet 1<sup>st</sup> Class.

## Try a School Lunch Day

On Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> January we are holding a 'Try a School Lunch Day' for the KS1 children.

The menu for the **whole school** on this day will be:

Organic Pork Sausages served with mash

or

Vegan Quorn nuggets served with mash

Both options are served with sweetcorn and baked beans followed by a shortbread biscuit.

Your child is entitled to a Free School Meal if they are in Reception, Year 1 or 2.

On 16<sup>th</sup> January **ALL** children from these year groups will be able to try a school lunch, freshly prepared in our on-site kitchen. If your child usually brings a packed lunch they may still do so, but will also have the opportunity to sample our delicious school lunches.

## Primary, infant and junior applications

You can apply for a place at a primary, infant or junior school from **4<sup>th</sup> November 2019**, if your child:

- was born between **1 September 2015** and **31 August**

**2016** they will be due to start school at either an infant or primary school in September 2020.

- is **leaving Year 2 of an infant school in July 2020** you will need to apply for a Year 3 place at a junior school or an all through primary school that has a year 3 entry to start in September 2020.

The closing date for on time applications for primary, infant and junior school is 15 January 2020.

If your child was born after 31 August 2016 you should start considering which schools you want to apply for at the beginning of the school year in which your child turns four. The annual closing date for applications is 15 January.
