**Year 6 SATs and 'Now Press Play'**

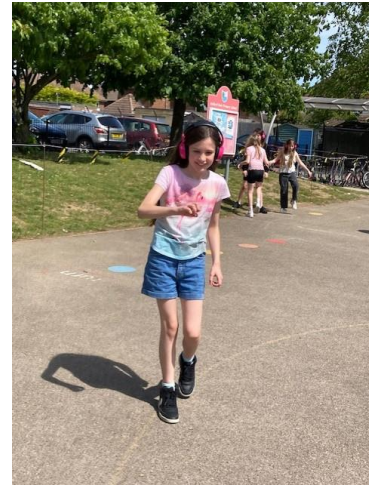
The significant majority of our year 6 children completed their SATs this week.
