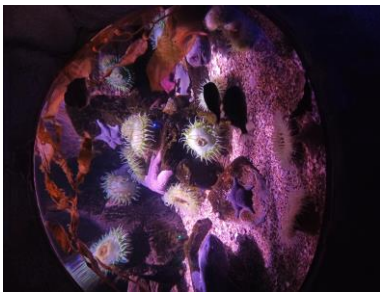




Safeguarding hotspot – taking photographs at Sports Days

On 8th June, Year 4 visited London Aquarium as a part of our Summer 2 Science learning, 'Blue Abyss'.



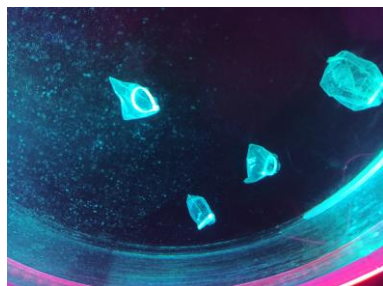
The purpose of the visit was to support our learning of an aquatic habitat and gain a unique insight into the world of the deep.
