Nixon completed an art activity on our topic Beachcombers

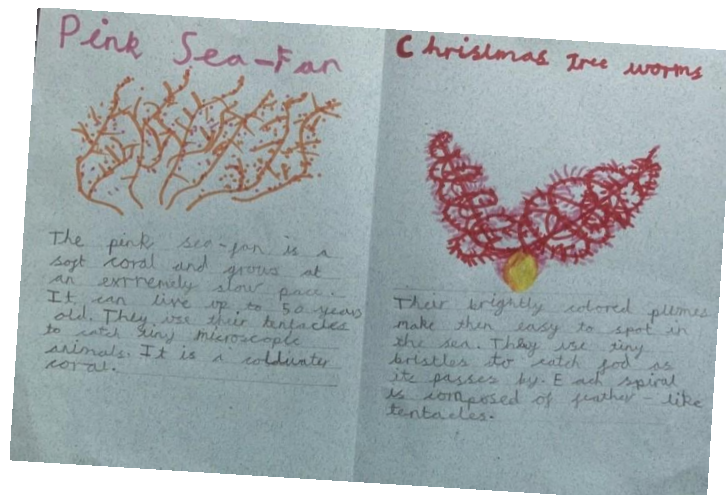
William drew a bar graph of the top favourite things to do at the seaside as part of our Beachcombers topic

Nixon wrote and performed a brilliant Sea Shore themed tongue twister including alliteration and rhyme

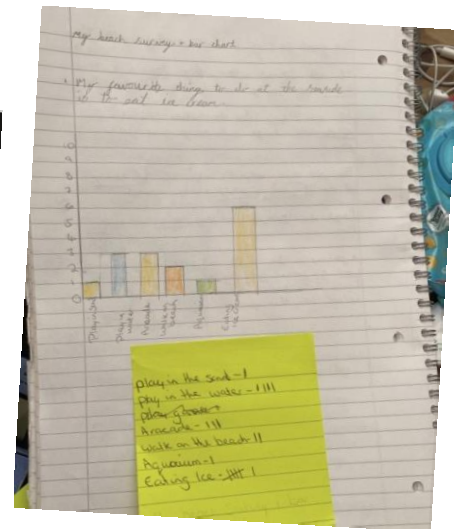
Chloe has researched unusual sea creatures as part of our topic 'Beachcombers' and has presented her work beautifully!

Olivia drew a bar chart to show different beach activities to show which was the most popular. Great work!

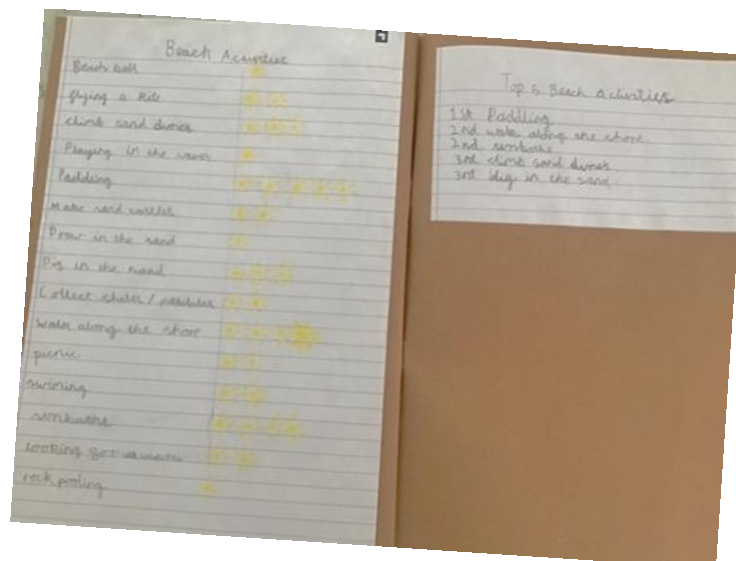
Benisha has learnt to ride her bike without stabilisers



Jasmine carried out an experiment to see which materials would dissolve in water

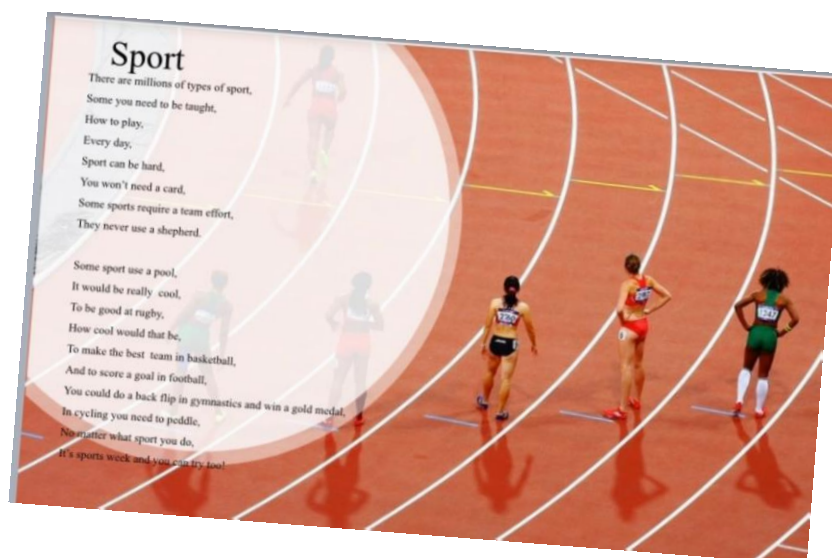


Nate has investigated popular beach activities and used a pictogram to show his results. Well done Nate!

Sophia used PowerPoint to create a fantastic poem about sports week.



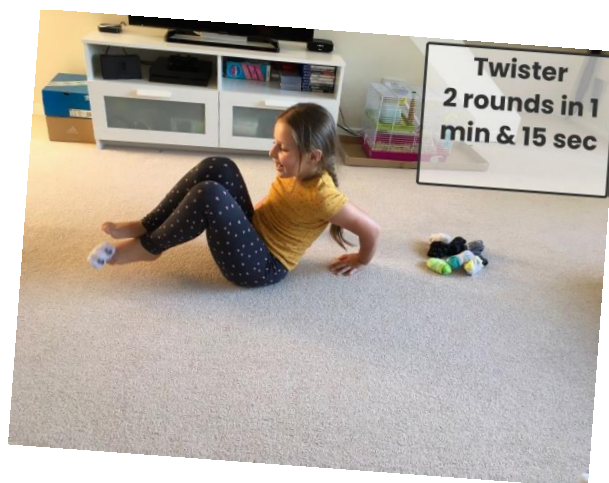
Amelia moved 26 cups in 1 minute and 30 seconds.
