Energy	Turning lights and whiteboards off when rooms are empty or its sunny.	All classrooms to have reminders to turn off lights and whiteboards.	February 2017	Whole School	We only found 7/16 classes had turned their lights and whiteboards off at lunch
Litter	To stop litter over playground and flower beds.	All Eco Committee members to remind children at playtimes to use the bins.	February 2017	Whole School	We didn't find any litter today. We were very pleased.
Waste Minimisation	Use scrap paper where possible. Children to bring in a colouring book for wet play to stop paper wastage.	All classrooms to have a scrap paper tray. All children to bring in a recycled colouring book for wet play.	February 2017	Eco-Committee to make sure their class has a scrap paper tray and it is being used also to write a letter to parents requesting a recycled colouring book.	We found 13/16 classes had a clearly labelled scrap paper tray. We have also requested in the newsletter the children bring in colouring books for wet playtimes.

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
