Return to School for EYFS, Year 1 & 6

Update to Questions and Answers that have arisen Friday 3rd July

Does the Year 6 picnic apply to all children?

Yes, it applies to all Year 6 children, even if they haven't returned to school since the lockdown.

The lunch is for everybody attending and there is no charge - lunch costs are being provided by the school. If your child is attending the Year 6 Picnic on Thursday 16th July, please confirm their lunch choice to Dinners@ashford-park.surrey.sch.uk **no later than 6pm on Monday 6th July**. A Parentmail was sent on 3rd July which detailed the lunch options.

Update to Questions and Answers that have arisen Friday 19th June

What should my child wear to school?

We request that children wear school PE kit as their summer uniform. The reason for this is that they will not need to get changed for outside learning / PE lessons and that the PE kit will be easier to wash and dry as the recommendation is that clothes are laundered daily. If the PE kit was left at school, please dress your child in something similar and ask them to bring the kit home on their first day back.

We will send these home with the children as soon as we can. Please note that we cannot leave these outside for collection, as these are orders that parents have paid for.
