Fire alarm evacuation

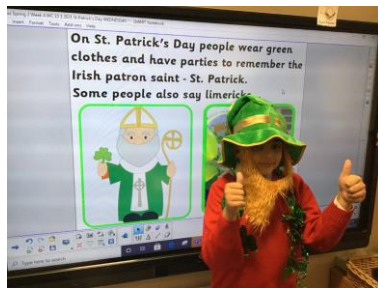
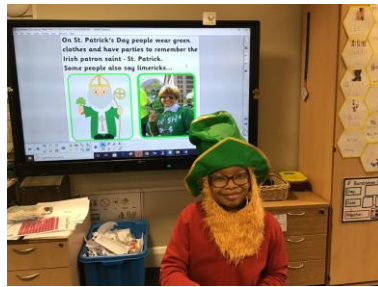
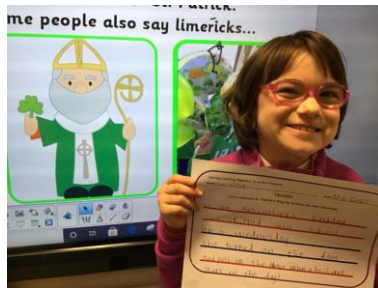
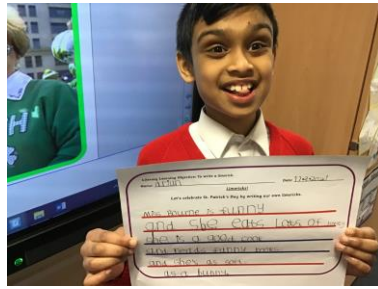

St Patrick's Day Learning

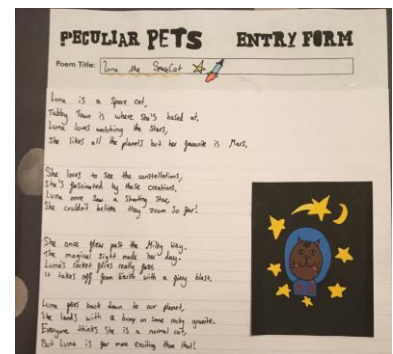


This week in Bumblebee Class, we have been finding out about Ireland. On Wednesday we had lots of fun celebrating St. Patrick's
