Safeguarding Hotspot

Internet Watch Foundation campaign has been launched to raise awareness of "self-generated" child sexual abuse material.

In the last year, "[self-generated](#)" [child sexual abuse imagery](#) has increased by 77% and is a third of all child sexual abuse material identified and removed from the internet. These included images of girls aged 11 to 13 whose abuse had been recorded via a webcam in a domestic setting.

To help prevent the creation of this type of abusive imagery, a campaign has been launched by the [Internet Watch Foundation](#) (IWF) backed by the Home Office and Microsoft.
