Updated Covid guidance - regular symptom free testing

All adults and secondary and college age students are encouraged to take a symptom-free LFD test twice a week. You will not need to isolate while waiting for the results of the symptom-free LFD test. Adults can collect a home testing kit from a [designated site](#) or order [online](#). Find out more about symptom-free testing [here](#).

Please see below updated guidance regarding close contacts of a PCR positive Covid case.

As an extra precaution, Public Health England (PHE) is now advising close contacts to get a COVID-19 PCR test (ideally 5 days after exposure or day five of isolation).

Nature Walk for Otter Class

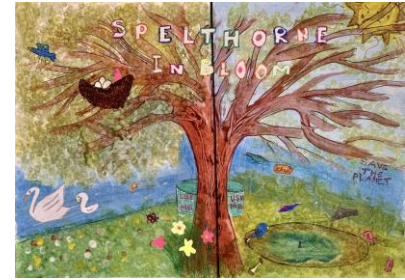
Otter Class enjoyed the great outdoors last Wednesday and went to the pond for a nature walk.
