Congratulations to our England football team who made it through to the Euro finals. Although we didn't win this match, we look forward to seeing our fantastic team take part in the World Cup next year!

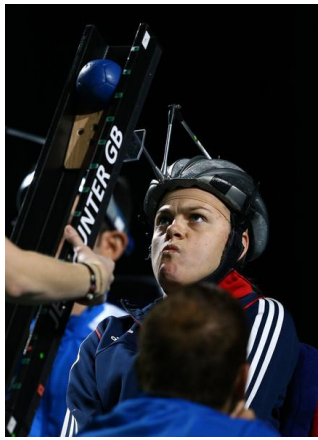
Olympic inspiration!
