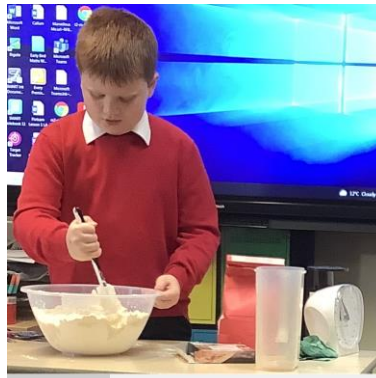
Year 2 Healthy Eating
