



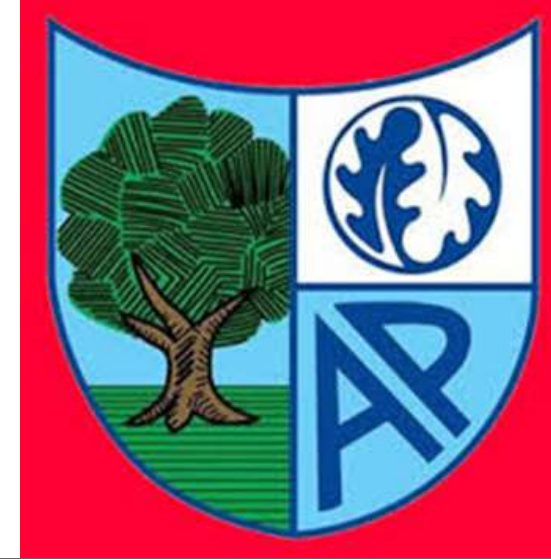

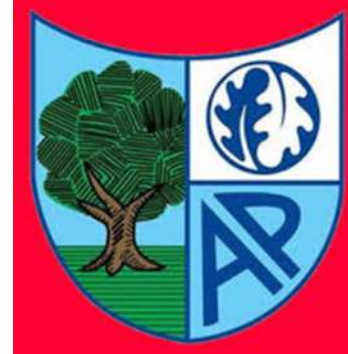


- Our accommodation for the trip will be in the Adventure Barns.

Safeguarding



- Schools have exclusive use of the site
- Ultimate Adventure team members are fully DBS checked
- The business is AALS (Adventure Activities Licensing Authority) registered. This is the mandatory requirement for centres offering adventure activities to young people under the age of 18. Safety Standards, staff training, child safe guarding, risk assessments and operating procedures are some of the regularly inspected elements of their business.
- All staff trained in safeguarding - Centre Manager is the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) and they also have other deputy safeguarding leads trained to Level 3 standards
