We are looking forward to another exciting term of learning.

Reception is the beginning of your journey here at Ashford Park Primary School and therefore, the expectations of behaviour and learning are high! Home Learning

- Now that the children are well established in their school routines it is especially important that we help them to share with you what they are learning in school and to continue that learning journey at home, in real-life situations. We send out an activity each week which should be completed via the Seesaw app <https://app.seesaw.me>
 - Reading books – our expectation is that children are read with at least 3 times a week at home. Each week, we will allocate an E-reader through Collins E-books. We will monitor this weekly. We will also send home a picture book each Tuesday for you to share with your child. Please make sure that the homework Reading Record book is filled in for both books and the Homework pack is returned to school each Monday.
 - Wow vouchers – Please use the Wow vouchers whenever your child has had a “Wow” moment at home, learnt a new task or done something they are proud of. Simply respond to the Seesaw post and we can share these in class.

- Please make sure that you have all signed up for Marvellous Me and look out for our messages as we enjoy celebrating your child’s successes.







PE Days & PE Kits
